Nursery newsletter-Summer Term 2024

Dear Parents,

We've been very busy since we started the new term and have warmly welcomed new friends into the class.

Our theme for summer term is 'Competition' and we will be asking – 'Are we all the same?' We will be completing lots of fun activities in class, learning about our similarities and differences, likes and dislikes, and investigating how high we can jump. We will discuss different sorts of team and what makes a good team. We will also be finding out about the Olympics/Paralympics and trying some of the sports.

Some of the activities we will be completing include: -

- Language and literacy Sound and name recognition/writing and letter formation. Sharing of a range of books on our theme with follow-up activities including role-play, letters, lists and sequencing. Revising Welsh greetings and questions including 'Pwy wyt ti?' 'Sut wyt ti?', 'Bore da', 'Prynhawn da', 'Hwyl fawr', 'Barod?' and learning 'Sut mae'r tywydd?'
- <u>Mathematics and numeracy</u> Counting, number recognition and formation, pictograms, shape, sorting, measuring, and capacity.
- Expressive arts Music and dance lessons with subject specialists, creating artwork and singing songs linked to the theme.
- **Health and Well-being** Discussion of similarities and differences between ourselves and our friends. Discussion of how we can be a good team member. Discussion of the importance of healthy eating and exercise. Taking part in different physical activities.
- <u>Humanities</u> Discussion of the Olympics, its history and where the Olympics/Paralympics will take place.
- <u>Science and Technology</u> Comparing our features with those of our friends and team t-shirt design.

Details of the books we will be looking at, our sound/number of the week and other information will continue to be shared weekly using Seesaw.
