A reminder about traffic safety

We want to take a moment to remind everyone about the importance of safe driving around the school, especially during drop-off and pick-up times.

We've had further reports from local residents about drivers not being as cautious as they should be when leaving the school grounds. The biggest concern is at the first junction, where some cars are turning right without properly checking for traffic from the left. This creates a serious safety risk for everyone.

The Highways Department will soon be adding 'give way' markings at this junction, but we need to act now to prevent any accidents. We ask all drivers to:

- Come to a complete stop at the junction.
- Look carefully in both directions before moving.

Keeping our children and community safe is something we all share responsibility for. Let's be mindful and set a positive example for our pupils by being courteous and careful road users.

Inclement weather school closure

With the unpredictable weather conditions that we often experience, it is necessary for us to have a plan in place for any potential school closures. If the school has to close due to adverse weather conditions, we will contact you via text message and email at the earliest opportunity.



Therefore, it is crucial that you ensure all your contact details are up to date and that you are receiving school communications regularly.

In the event of a school closure, our dedicated teaching staff will set work for the children using various online platforms. For Nursery, Reception, Year 1, Year 2, and Year 3, the work will be set on Seesaw. On the other hand, Years 4, 5, and 6 will have their work set on Google Classroom via Hwb. These platforms have been chosen to ensure a seamless continuation of your child's education from the comfort of your home.

To ensure a smooth transition to online learning, please make sure that you have your child's login details readily available. Our staff will be unable to provide these details if the school has to close at short notice.

We sincerely hope that adverse weather conditions do not disrupt our school operations. However, it is always better to be prepared. We will continue to monitor the weather closely and if any closures are necessary, we will inform you promptly.
